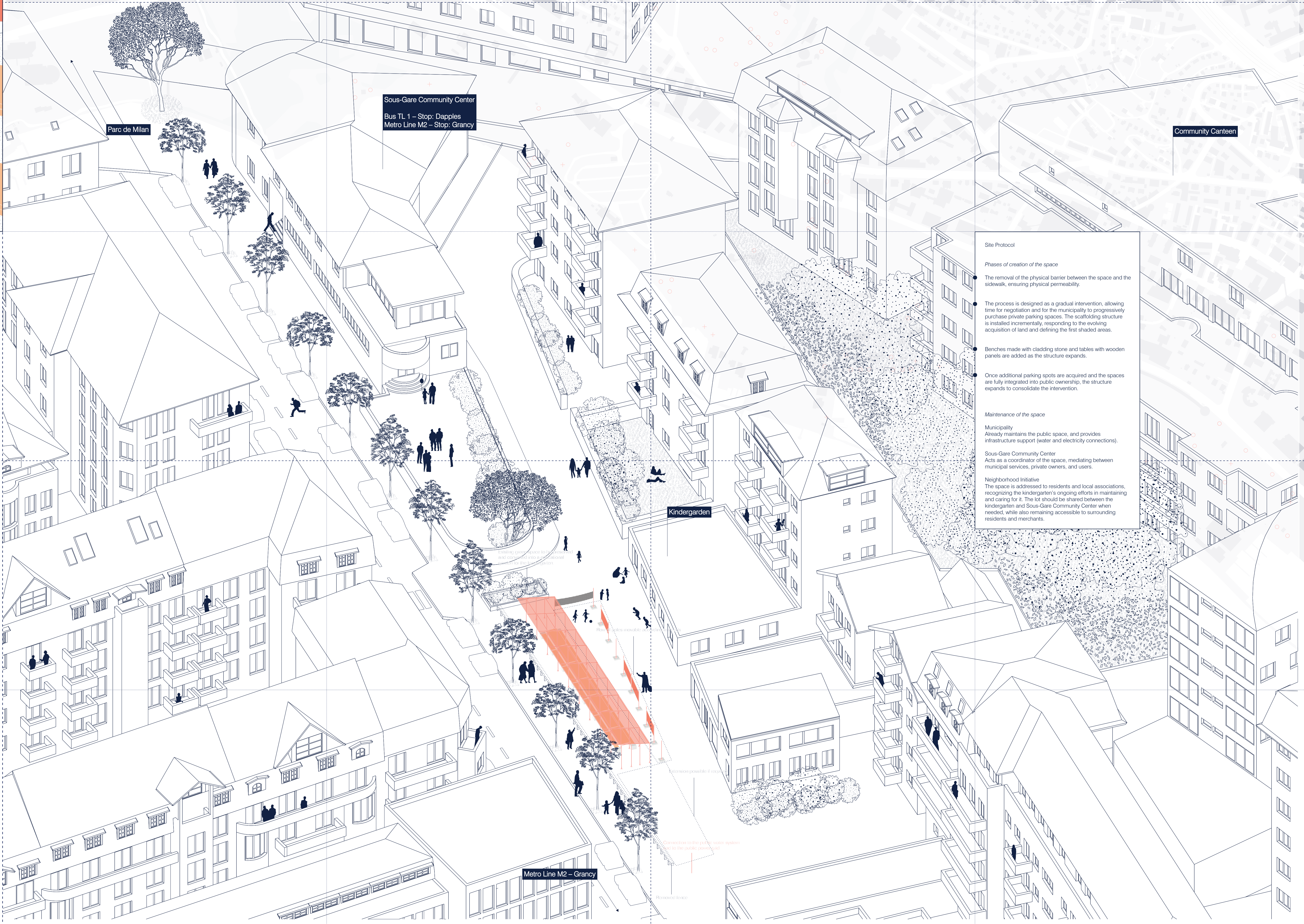
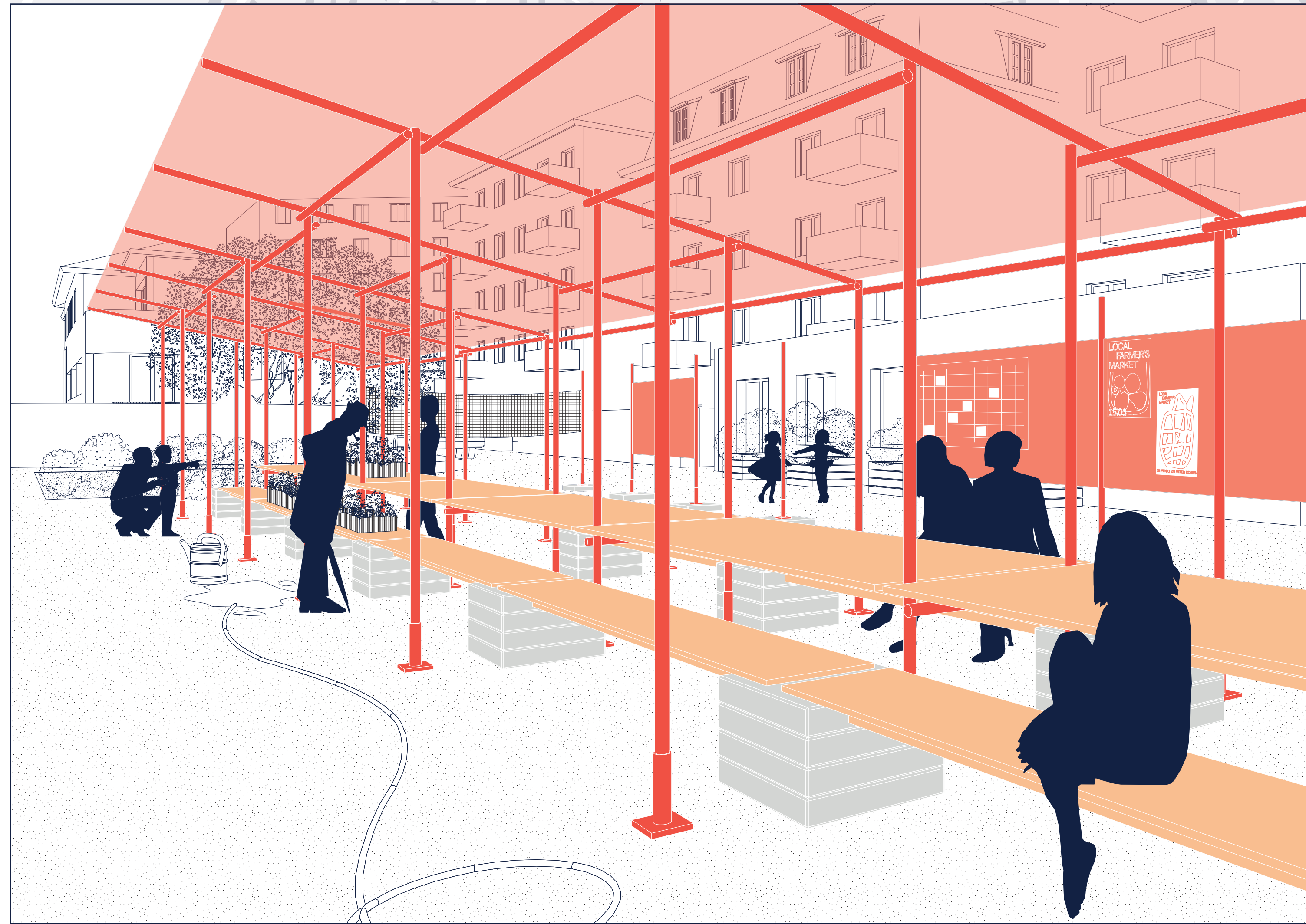




Site Protocol

**Phases of creation of the space**

- The removal of the physical barrier between the space and the sidewalk, ensuring physical permeability.
- The process is designed as a gradual intervention, allowing time for negotiation and for the municipality to progressively purchase private parking spaces. The scaffolding structure is installed incrementally, responding to the evolving acquisition of land and defining the first shaded areas.
- Benches made with cladding stone and tables with wooden panels are added as the structure expands.
- Once additional parking spots are acquired and the spaces are fully integrated into public ownership, the structure expands to consolidate the intervention.

**Maintenance of the space**

**Municipality**  
Already maintains the public space, and provides infrastructure support (water and electricity connections).

**Sous-Gare Community Center**  
Acts as a coordinator of the space, mediating between municipal services, private owners, and users.

**Neighborhood Initiative**  
The space is addressed to residents and local associations, recognizing the kindergarten's ongoing efforts in maintaining and caring for it. The lot should be shared between the kindergarten and Sous-Gare Community Center when needed, while also remaining accessible to surrounding residents and merchants.
